

The Arabic words used to denote Cause in the following verses of the Qur'an are:

- *badi'*, which means "originator", "initiator" and "creator out of nonentity"
- *bari*', which mean "creator" and "one who creates flawlessly out of nothing"
- *fatir*, which means "creator", "maker", "originator", "initiator", "one who splits" and "one who brings into being"
- *khaliq*, which means "creator", "maker" and "originator"
- *al-khallaq*, which means "creator" and "supreme maker"



He [God] is the **Originator** of the heavens and the earth. How can He have children when He has no wife? He created all things and He is the All-Knower of everything.²

And [remember] when Musa [Prophet Moses] said to his people, "O my people! Verily you have wronged yourselves by worshipping the calf. So turn in repentance to your **Creator** and kill yourselves [the innocent kill the wrongdoers among you], that will be better for you with your **Creator**." Then He [God] accepted your repentance. Truly He is the One Who accepts repentance, the Most Merciful.³

Say [O Muhammad], "Shall I take as a Lord-Protector any other than Allah the **Creator** of the heavens and earth? And it is He Who feeds but is not fed." Say, "Verily, I am commanded to be the first of those who submit themselves to Allah." And be not you [O Muhammad] of the polytheists.⁵

"My Lord! You have indeed bestowed on me sovereignty and taught me something of the interpretation of dreams – the **Creator** of the heavens and earth! You are my Lord-Protector in this world and in the Hereafter. Cause me to die as a Muslim and join me with the righteous."⁶

Their Messengers said, "What! Can there be doubt about Allah the **Creator** of the heavens and earth? He calls you that He may forgive you of your sins, and give you respite for term appointed." They said, "You are no more than human beings like us! You wish to turn us away from what out fathers used to worship. Then bring us a clear authority."⁷



Say [O Muhammad], "Who is Lord of the heavens and earth?" Say, "Allah." 
Allah is the **Creator** of all things, and He is the Guardian-Trustee over all things.¹³
